Train line: **Werribee** or **Laverton** line

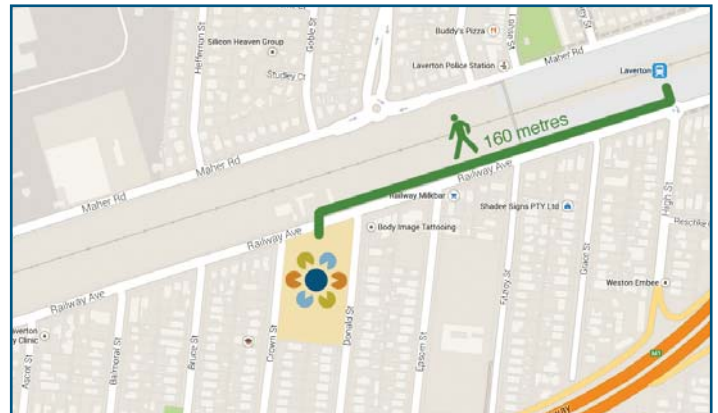
Bus routes: **411, 412, 414, 415**

Accessibility

The Centre is predominantly accessed by sliding doors at all entry points; has four fully accessible toilets; adult hoist and adult change table; high contrast colour between wall and floor surfaces for the visually impaired; tactile pavers indicating change in levels and obstructions; Braille signage where possible; level surface throughout the building (no steps); wide corridors and paths of travel; low accessible reception desk; and a hearing loop.
