CWA

A CWA is a Complying written agreement. A CWA must be in writing, which includes either hardcopy (paper) or electronic form.

A CWA is sent each time there is a change in circumstances to the enrolment. These are a requirement to [DESE](#) or Centrelink

A CWA is a contract between the service and an individual. Providers are required to submit an enrolment notice for each child that starts to be enrolled under a CWA, including relevant details about the terms of the arrangement, which the individual will be asked to confirm ([2.6.5.10](#)).

We would recommend that these are checked that the details are correct.

COVID

There have been some changes regarding mask wearing in early childhood centres. It is now an expectation that all visitors will wear a mask in the service.

We are mindful that many are now out of the habit of wearing masks. For this we have placed a box of masks at the front door, please help yourself should you need one.
