All staff are trained and supported to document children's learning and development. Most of the children's learning is captured via Kindyhub.

If at any stage, you would like to discuss your children's development your educators can make a time to meet with you either onsite or via zoom or a phone call. If you have any concerns regarding your child's development, it is best to have the discussions sooner rather than later. It can take a long time to see external professionals such as paediatricians or other medical professionals. There is also profound evidence that early intervention can have a profound impact on children's development and wellbeing.

It is a requirement that all staff working in early childhood education must have their booster before the end of February. This is a legislated requirement for the profession.
